Jing: allows you to capture a screen shot, or a selection on your screen and save it as a file on your computer



Newsela: non-fiction text from 3rd grade- adult level. Each current event article has five levels, interactive text tools, and comprehension activities



Next Generation Science app: organizes the standards into grade level and science concentration



Readworks.org: leveled text, lessons, units, paired text all organized by skill or subject matter



Remind: offers teachers a free, safe and easy-to-use way to instantly send one-way texts to students and parents without exchanging numbers. Teachers can send or schedule reminders, assignments, homework, assessments, or motivational messages directly to students' and parents' phones. Also has a feature to send file attachments



Safeshare.tv: show a youtube video safely without students seeing other recommendations on the side



Tiny Scan: take a picture of text, poster, worksheet, etc. and this app creates it into a PDF as if you scanned it



Typingweb.com: free typing tutorial program online
